Metrological fees

Instructions No. (7) for the year 2001
Issued according to article no. 27 of the Standard and Metrology Law
No. (22) for the year 2000

Article (1) These instructions shall be designated "Instructions of metrological fees" no. 7 for the year 2001 and shall be effective at 01-01-2002.

Article (2) These instructions will define the metrological fees paid to the institution according to the metrological services offered as shown in the following tables:

Article (3) The fees listed in the tables are for metrological services and not including the transportation of the employees, stay allowance, overtime and also transportation of the standards used for calibration and verification and other costs.

Article (4) The client should pay the recompense for transportation of the employees, stay allowance and overtime directly for the institution, the institution can ask for extra fees in case of recalibration and verification or in case of asking assistance from external or internal bodies for calibration, verification, pattern approval, auditing of workshop for maintenance and repair or delegation of authorities for calibration bodies.

Article (5) Initial verification is done for measuring instruments that will be used for the first time. Reports and certificates are issued according to the verification results. Periodic verification will be done for the legal measuring instruments.

Article (6) The verification fees will be paid for the whole imported or manufactured quantity except for items mentioned in article 2-a, fees will be according to the samples taken from the lot.

Article (7) Pattern approval fees will be paid for the first time only.

Article (8) Fees for transportation of measurement standards (not including the calibration fees) will be as following:

Karaq, Maa'n, Tafileh, Aqaba	60

Article (9) In weighing bridges, if they are not prepared for calibration for any reason 35% of the fees will be paid instead of transportation of measurement standards.

Article (10) 200 JD will be paid to the institution for the evaluation of the maintenance workshops, and 100 JD for reevaluation in case of giving license or renewal of license.

Article (11) 300 JD will be paid to the institution for the evaluation in case of delegating authority for calibration services, and 250 JD for reevaluation in case of giving or renewal of delegation.

Article (12) These instructions will be applied on all measuring instruments, imported or manufactured.

Article (13) These instructions cancel metrological fees instructions no 9 for the year 1997.
